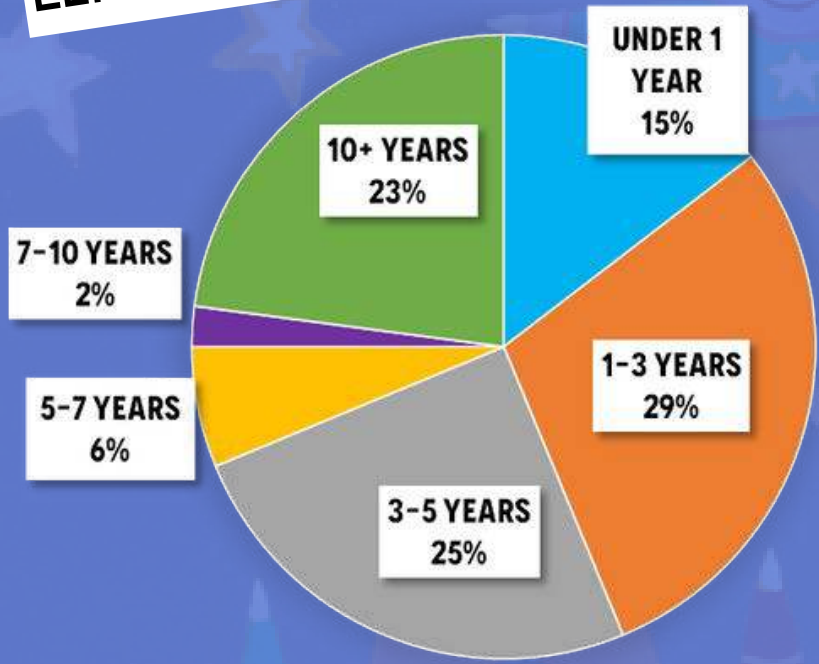

78% identify as women

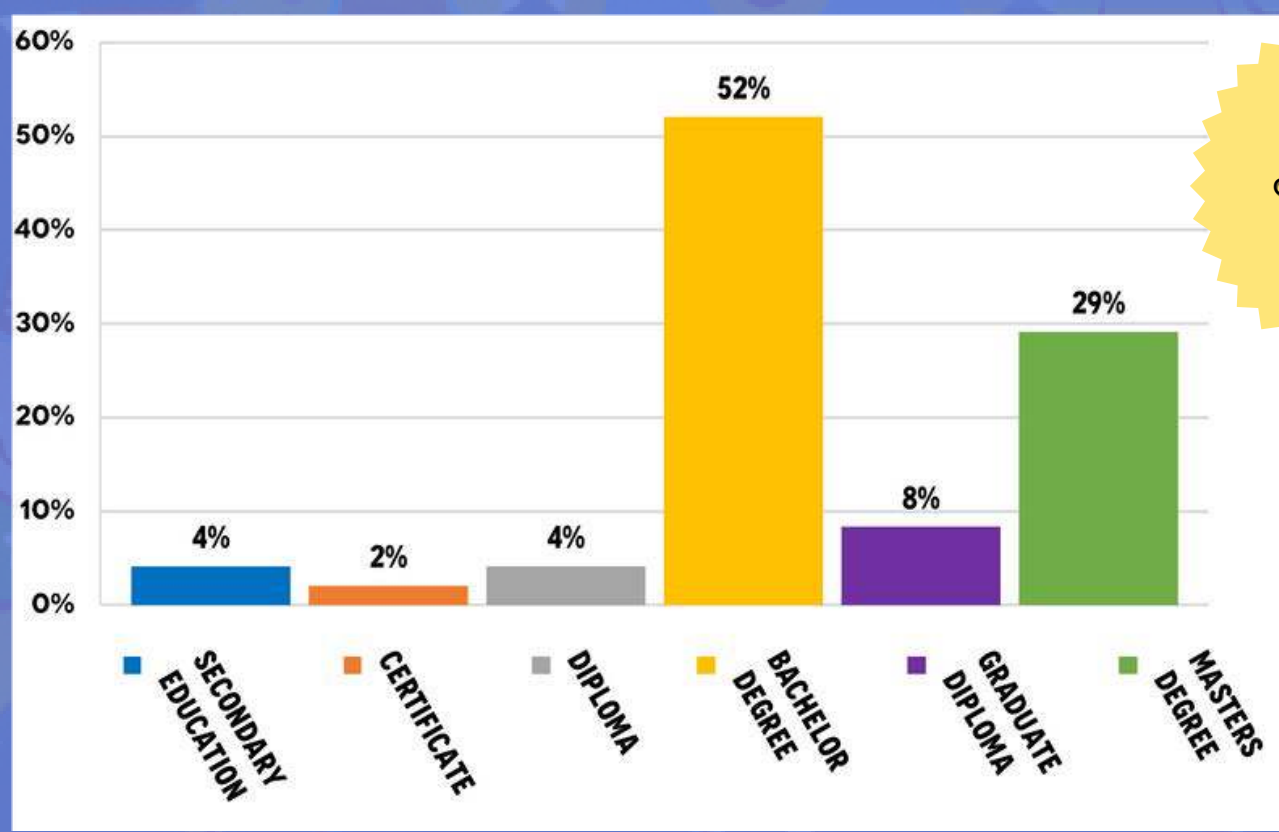
12% identify as non-binary or non-conforming
